CCCA Passport Driving Program

(REVISED)

This new Driving Program is about the joy of owning a Classic Car and the true thrill of taking the wheel to use them as they were originally attended – for motoring. Mileage Car Badges are awarded based on the miles that you drive your full classic. The first badge comes at 1,000 miles, additional badges are awarded as you achieve higher mileage. To register your cars the odometer reading must be verified, and a registration form filled out and mailed to CCCA with a fee of \$25 per car. This is a good program to promote driving our cars.
